2023 BCRA POLARIS CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS GROUND RULES

1. Mandatory contestant meeting Saturday September 2nd, at 11 am sharp.
All finalists must be in western attire for the competitors meeting or be subject to a \$50 dress code fine.
Photos will be taken at this time.
2. All contestants are required to be present for grand entry.
Select contestants from the draw will be required to pack flags each day.
Please arrive 15 minutes before the 1:30 performance start time at the timed event end of the Arena.
Those on foot - please enter the Arena in a timely fashion when your name is called in your respective event.
3. Only the Jr and PeeWee's receive one companion pass.
All other companions must buy a pass.
All contestants must show their membership card for free entry. PLEASE have your BCRA card ready when arriving at the gate.
Failure to show your card will result in having to pay for a weekend pass of \$56 for adults.
You will be given a parking pass to hang on your mirror.
Wristbands must be worn for the entire weekend.
Abuse of the gate/parking people will not be tolerated.
4. Rough Stock contestants and ONE helper and designated Volunteers must have a Fall Fair chute access wristband on to get behind the chutes. Wristbands will be given out at the Rodeo Office when entries are paid.
5. No tolerance for mistreatment of livestock (animal or any kind) in or around the Arena.
Failure to comply will result in fines/suspensions/disqualification at the discretion of the BOD.
6. Dogs are not allowed on the grounds but exceptions have been made and contestants may keep their dog on a leash at their truck and trailer. Fine will be \$100 for every infraction.
7. Stalls are \$10 per night.
A fine of \$250 will be assessed if not cleaned (will be on ineligible list until paid)
8. Please rake manure in piles away from the racetrack rail and leave in a pile. The Fall Fair will pick up once parking lot is empty.
Please clean up your camping area.
9. Please park respectfully and as tight as possible. If not parked appropriately - you may be asked to move.
10. Underage drinking will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification.
11. No open flame of any kind (including propane fire pits).
12. ALL stock to be run thru - preferably on Friday but must be done before 9 am Saturday morning.
13. Alcohol, smoking, vaping or drugs are not allowed in competitor's area or in and around the Arena.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The BCRA Championship Finals qualifiers shall carry previous earnings into the BCRA Finals towards Event Championship saddles.

All Finalists must attend the mandatory competitors meeting held prior to the first go-round. Failure to attend will result in a \$100 fine. Western dress code is mandatory.

ORDER OF GO:

Season Standings will be decided as follows with highest money earner in each determined spot

1. Top ten of BCRA season standings; determined order by monies earned
2. BCHSRA/BCLBRA champion is 11th spot

ALL EVENTS EXCEPT BARRELS:

- 1st Go Round: Reverse Order of Season Standings
2nd Go Round: Reverse Order of Season Standings
3rd Go Round: Order of Go determined from 1st, 2nd Go Rounds. Contestants with 0 pts going into the 3rd go round will be placed as per times/scores from first two go rounds. If no times/scores then determine by season standings.

BARREL RACING EVENTS:

- 1st Go Round: Season Leader will go first. (1-10 in season standings)
2nd Go Round: Drop Three from order in first go round.
3rd Go Round: Order of go will be determined by average. Leader of finals average will run first.

TEAM ROPING:

- 1st Go Round: Reverse Order of season standings based on the top money earner of each team.
2nd Go Round: Reverse Order of season standings based on the top money earner of each team.
3rd Go Round: Order of Go determined from 1st, 2nd Go Rounds. Contestants with 0 pts going into the 3rd go round will be placed as per times/scores from first two go rounds. If no times/scores then determine by season standings.

Those competitors entering the third go-round with zero points will be placed based on fastest or highest average time/score or if no times/score, reverse order of the season standings.

A finals champion will be awarded based on points with the average points included. The average will be based on total accumulated scores and times in all go-rounds.

Champions will be determined on the following point system: 50, 40, 30, 20, 10 in each go-round and average.

- If a tie occurs in a go around or the average, the points will be split accordingly.
- If a tie occurs after points from all go rounds and the average have been totaled, a ride-off or run-off will be called.
- The order of the ride-off or run-off will be determined by a coin toss.
- Where possible, the ride-off or run-off will take place before any other event begins.
- TIME LIMITS at the BCRA Championship Finals Rodeo, all timed events have a flat 30 second time limit, excluding penalties.
- At the BCRA Finals contestants will not be disqualified for pulling up in the barrel racing event. Time will be recorded for average.
- If a BCRA Finalist needs to medical out of the Finals once it has begun, the next competitor in the season standings who has entered the finals may be called to compete at the finals for go-round money only. Must pay an entry fee
